MSK has placed the following restrictions to protect the health and safety of our staff and patients as MSK continues to take steps to ensure preparedness for COVID-19:

- Effective immediately, MSK is canceling all in-person work-related gatherings that include external participants. External participant is defined as a non- MSK employee.

In response to the above MSK restriction, effective **March 11, 2020**, Clinical Research Administration (CRA) is postponing all in-person research meetings that include external participants.

This includes, but is not limited to, on-site monitoring visits, Site Initiation Visits (SIVs), onsite feasibility visits, Industrial Sponsor-PI in-person meetings, onsite pharmacy visits, audits, and any other in-person research meetings.

These restrictions will be in place through at least April 30th. All research meetings should be performed remotely when possible. If remote is not an option, they are to be postponed until further notice. MSK research staff will work with you on rescheduling these meetings and visits.

This restriction will be revisited on April 30th.

As of March 10, there are currently no restrictions on patient visits. Protocol visits will continue to occur as planned.
