★ Types of adverse events

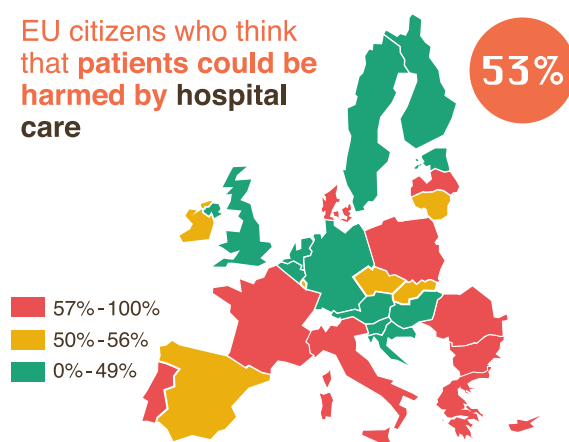
Healthcare-associated infections (HAI):

are directly responsible for **37000** deaths / year
 contribute to a further **110000** deaths / year
 cost hospitals over **€5.4 billion** / year

Medication-related errors	Surgical errors
Medical device failures	Errors in diagnosis
Failure to act on the results of tests	

★ Patients think they can be harmed

EU citizens who think that patients could be harmed by hospital care



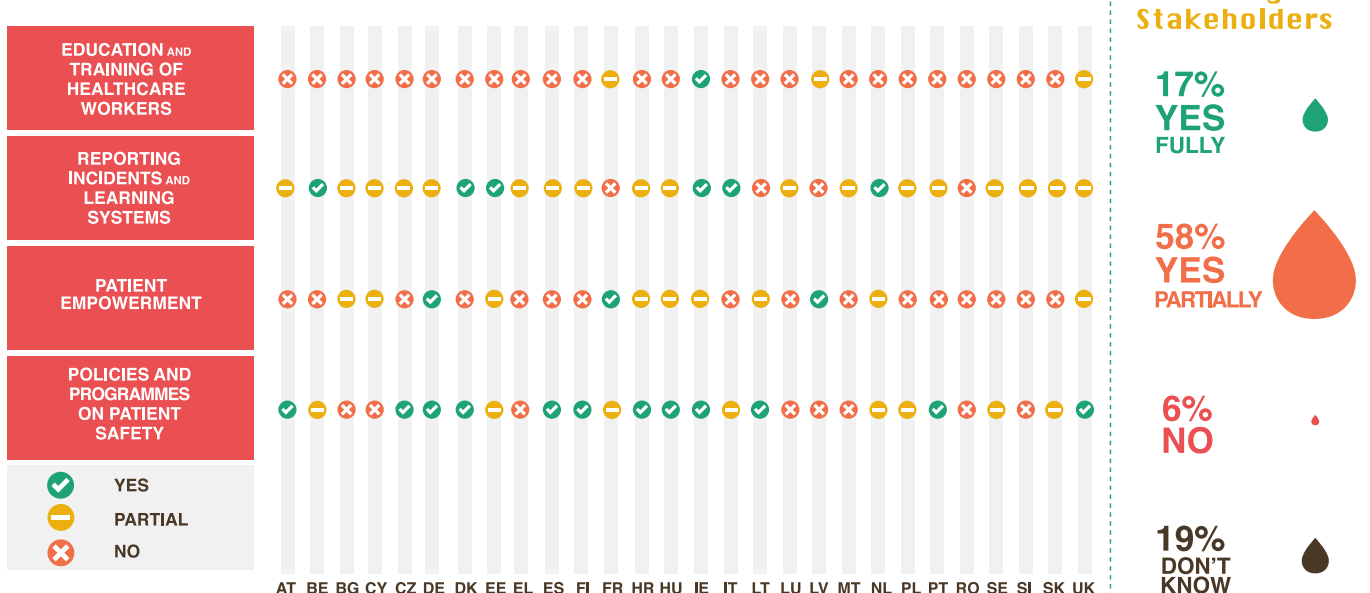
★ **91%** of **STAKEHOLDERS** think patient safety is an issue

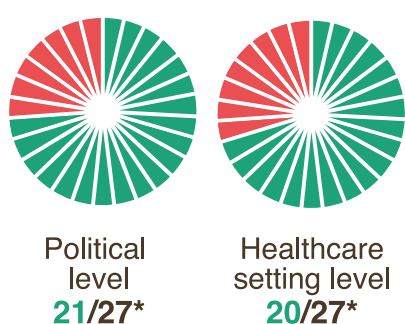

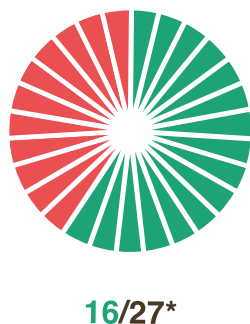

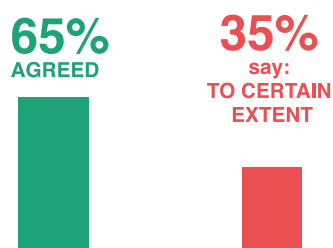

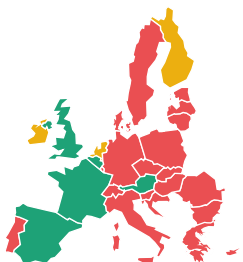

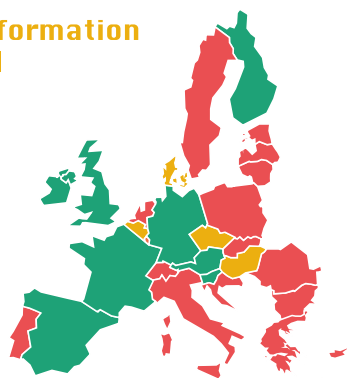

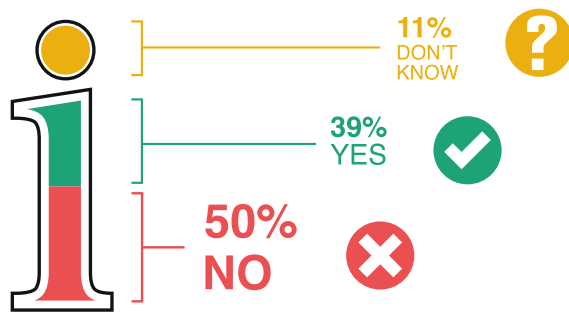
